 Lydia knew and loved God. She showed goodness because she had the help of the Spirit to share God's love and goodness.
- 5. What makes it difficult for you to be good? Sometimes it can be difficult to be good, and we don't always feel like being good. But when we love God and follow Jesus, like Lydia, God gives us the gift of his Spirit. He helps us show goodness by treating others well so we can share God's love with everyone.
