




God Gives New Life

Questions:

- 1. Read Acts 9:2. What was Paul on his way to do? (Find followers of Jesus and put them in jail)
- 2. Read verse 5. Who did Paul meet on his journey to Damascus? (Jesus.)
- 3. Read Acts 9:8–9. What happened to Paul after he saw Jesus? (He went blind.)
- 4. Read Acts 9:13–14. How did Ananias respond when the Lord told him that Paul would be coming to his home? (Ananias said he knew that Paul had done harm to God's people.)
- 5. Read verse 15. What did the Lord tell Ananias about Paul? (Paul would be God's chosen instrument.)
- 6. What part do you think you can play in The Big God Story?
