Week of October 22

Text: Revelation 10 & 11

What do you notice about the text?

- What sticks out to you (words, phrases, concepts, themes)?
- Why do these stick out to you?
- What is going on before and after this passage?
- Does this remind you of other parts of the Bible?

Understand

- What questions does this passage raise for you?
- What does this passage tell you about God?
- Just as there is a pause here before the seventh trumpet, there was a pause before the seventh seal (Revelation 7:1-17). What other similarities do you find in these two sections?

Life

- How does this passage impact your life? Think about your relationship with God, others, the world, your attitude, habits, decisions, how you use your time, how you view the future.
- These chapters emphasize spreading the Gospel (John prophesying in 10:11, the two witnesses in ch. 11). While those who dwell on the earth reject and kill the two witnesses, they eventually "gave glory to the God of Heaven" (11:13). How does that encourage us to continue to spread the gospel, even when it is difficult or seems hopeless?
