Understand

- What questions does this passage raise for you?
- What does this passage tell you about God?
- What are the different responses to this fall of Babylon in the text, both by those who are Christians and those who are not? What are the reasons in the text for the different responses?

Life

- How does this passage impact your life? Think about your relationship with God, others, the world, your attitude, habits, decisions, how you use your time, how you view the future.
- What parts of our society or culture do we find ourselves continually drawn to? What guards might we have against this to avoid Revelation 18:4 "lest you take part in her sins, lest you share in her plagues;"
