Text

- What do you notice about the text?
 - What sticks out to you (words, phrases, concepts, themes)?
 - Why do these stick out to you?
 - What is going on before and after this passage?
 - Does this remind you of other parts of the Bible?

Understand

- What questions does this passage raise for you?
- What does this passage tell you about God?
- How does the marriage supper of the Lamb differ from the drunken gatherings of the women in Revelation 18? How do Isaiah 25:6-9 and Luke 14: help us to see who are these "blessed," invited people.
- What details are we given about the rider on a white horse? What sticks out to you from these?

Life

- How does this passage impact your life? Think about your relationship with God, others, the world, your attitude, habits, decisions, how you use your time, how you view the future.
- Praise in Revelation 19:1 erupts in response to God's salvation, glory, and power. How have you seen these things in the book of Revelation? Have they caused you to praise him?
