

With the explosion in video, our team continues to go places never possible before. This past year we had visitors to our website from over 167 countries and 3,690 cities in Colorado. Web visitors topped 579,000 views! Social media is a dominant tool that helps us reach people with no previous connection to our campuses. Our weekly email is also a great tool to communicate what is happening at Calvary. Last year, we sent 90,140 total emails to our mid-week subscribers and had an open rate of 60.5%. On Sunday mornings we engage in worship through prayer, bible reading, music, giving, and teaching.



RENOVATIONS

We're excited to share that the Boulder first floor renovation is complete! Updates include new carpeting, fresh paint, stained concrete hallways, a fully refreshed sanctuary, an upgraded ramp, and improvements to the Fellowship Hall (now renamed the Community Room). Lighting has been enhanced throughout the building.

In Erie, the lobby has been upgraded to better serve our growing middle school ministry. We've also installed new AV equipment across all campuses. Looking ahead, we plan to install outdoor security cameras to help ensure a safe and welcoming environment for all.



We've seen a 13% increase in attendance over the past year. We're deeply grateful to God for every individual and family who has become part of the Calvary community. It is a true honor to walk alongside them and point them to Jesus.

STAFFING

This year, we welcomed several key staff transitions and additions. We hired a new Director of Women's Ministry in Boulder and a new High School Director in Erie. Additionally, we brought on a Senior Accountant to support our growing operational needs. In response to continued growth in Erie, we've expanded our team there as well.
