
A Conversation Guide DRIVER'S LICENSE

Driver's License: A Conversation Guide

For Parents and Teens

This resource has been created as a parent-teen conversation guide to accompany the milestone of getting a driver's license. This guide includes interactive elements like reflection prompts, joint activities, and a prayer in hopes to foster connection, trust, and celebration between parent and teen. Make this guide and special moment your own and have fun connecting with your teen!



1. START WITH CELEBRATION

Today is a big day—you're celebrating your teen's independence, responsibility, and this significant and exciting step into adulthood.

- Invite each person to share 1 word or emoji that describes how they're feeling right now.
- Take a "Keys & Cake" Photo—mark the moment with a picture, or celebrate with a small treat (your teen's favorite drink or dessert).

2. DEEPEN THE CONVERSATION: 6 QUESTIONS FOR THE ROAD AHEAD

(These connect directly to each section of the attached prayer)

- Identity (Rooted in Christ): What helps you remember who you are when you feel pressure to impress others?
- Independence (Growing in Grace): What part of driving feels the most exciting? What feels a little intimidating?
- Insight (Driving with Discernment): What does it mean to drive not just safely, but wisely?
- Integrity (Trusting and Truthful): What's one decision you might face as a driver that could test your values?
- Intercession (Prayer and Protection): How can I (the parent) pray for you as a new driver? Do you have any concerns I can pray for?
- Intentional Parenting (Releasing with Faith): How can I (the parent) support your independence while still staying connected to you?

3. WRITE A "FAMILY ROAD CODE" (see attached Family Road Code)

Together, create (or talk through the attached Code) a short Road Code that includes:

- 3 promises the teen makes (e.g., "I will drive phone-free")
- 2 hopes the parent has (e.g., "That you'll call me anytime, no judgment")
- 1 safety plan (e.g., "If I'm in an unsafe situation, I'll text our code word: _____")

4. PRAY TOGETHER (see attached Prayer for the Road Ahead)

Finally, invite God into this moment and into this important part of your life (parents, too!) He cares about all of it—how we drive, who we drive and where we go. You may use the attached Driver's License Prayer and take turns reading each section of the prayer aloud.

- Let me drive with honesty and humility.
- Help me be trustworthy—with time, decisions, and friends.
- Keep me anchored in Your truth when I'm tempted to prove myself.

5. Intercession – Covered in Prayer and Protection

- God, we ask for Your protection over every journey—long or short.
- Surround the car I drive and every passenger with Your peace.
- Remind me I'm never alone—You are beside, before and behind me.

6. Intentional Parenting – Releasing with Faith

- Lord, help me as a parent to guide without gripping too tightly.
- Grow my trust in You as I let go a little more.
- Give me wisdom to encourage, courage to release, and peace to trust Your plans for my child's future.
