Discussion Questions

Text: John 9:1-41

Icebreaker:

- What are you looking forward to most in the next six weeks?
- What are you dreading most?
- What does it look like for God to meet you where you are in this season?

1. Read this week's passage. What stands out from the text or sermon?
2. The man in John 9, born blind but now healed by Jesus, is confronted with many questions. He responds by saying, "One thing I do know, that though I was blind, now I see." At Calvary, one of our shaping values is *Confident Witness*. Our hope is that believers at Calvary would be confident to share their own stories of how Jesus has worked in their lives. Just like the man born blind in John, knowing all the answers is not a requirement. What you do know is your own story and confidence will come with practice. In 2-3 minutes, use the example of the blind man as template to tell your own story. What was your life like before you met Jesus and what difference does he make in your life now?

You can do this together as one large group or break up into smaller groups of 2-3. Encourage everyone that these testimonies can include their story of coming to faith in Jesus for the first time or any small story of witnessing Jesus work in their life.
